Writing Prompt:

Write a one-paragraph description based on the image you see on the overhead.

Watch what you capitalize, where you use punctuation (periods, commas, apostrophes, etc.), and how you spell.

Writing Format:

Look at the picture on the overhead projector carefully, noticing the sensory details of:



Sight – What do you see?

Sound – Can you hear anything in the air (voices, music, animals, or cars)?

Smells – Imagine the scents from nearby places, open doors, or people.

Touch – If you ran your hands across walls, floors, fabric, or other surfaces, how would you describe the feeling?

Taste – Use the flavors of things to help you describe the scene in the image.

You are describing this picture to someone who cannot see it. Include as much detail as possible so your words paint a powerful image.

Writing Requirements:

1. Must have an original title.
2. Must be written with complete sentences.
3. Must use details that appeal to all five senses.
